RULES:

1. All entries must be entered on-line using Showday online, or paper entries can be delivered to the Show Office in the week prior.
2. All exhibits must be at the Show Pavilion between 8am and 10.30am on Friday 7th July 2018. Exhibits may be delivered early by contacting the Chief Steward who will arrange a suitable time and place.
3. Entry Fees – all classes – \$1.00 - Limit of two entries per class. No exhibit is acceptable unless an entry fee has been paid and a completed entry form forwarded to the steward.
4. All Exhibitors are required to declare their **Biosecurity Number** when entering an exhibit. No number – no entry.
5. Judging commences at 11am on Friday 6th July 2018.
6. Prize Money to be collected from Administration Building after 9am on Saturday 7th July and until 5pm on Sunday 8th July. Money not collected during that time will be forfeited to the Dayboro A.H.& I. Association Inc.
7. Honey must be shown in the standard trade jar approved by the Queensland Beekeepers' Association. The jar is round (not panelled) and of clear glass with white lid. It measures approximately 120mm with cap diameter 62mm and contains 500g reputed net weight of honey. To expedite judging, jars should be filled to capacity.
An air space of 6mm to be left at the top of jar.
All jars are to be clear of all markings, stickers or identification marks.
Only stickers are to be ones placed on jars by stewards to identify entrants.

Comb Honey: Cut combs and frames of comb must be free of paper and decorative borders so that all the comb surface can be judged. Frames to be exhibited in single frame observatory hive, painted gloss white.

Mead: Entries to be in Clear Plastic 1.25ltr PET bottles for judging, clear of all markings, stickers or identification marks.

PRIZE MONEY: First \$10 Second \$ 8 Third \$5

OPEN SECTION

1. Two 500 gram bottles of Extracted Honey - Light
2. Two 500 gram bottles of Extracted Honey - Golden
3. Two 500 gram bottles of Extracted Honey - Dark
4. Two 500 gram bottles of Extracted Honey any colour for competitors who have not won a prize at the DAYBORO SHOW.
5. Two 500 gram bottles of Granulated Honey - fine grain
6. Two 500 gram bottles of Granulated Honey – coarse grain
7. Two 500 gram bottles of Creamed Honey.
8. One Frame of Comb Honey
9. Beeswax, for Retail Trade: Yellow/White – minimum display of five tablets – Total weight minimum of 1kg.
10. Two sections of Cut Comb of not less than 250 grams of uniform size in transparent containers
11. One kilo Wax – natural yellow
12. One kilo Wax – natural white
13. Novelty collection of Wax
14. 500 grams Wax – any colour from Novice Beekeeper
15. Junior Entry – Novelty Collection of Wax (up to 16 years of age)
16. Mead – Please label – Dry, Sweet, Fruit Infused.
