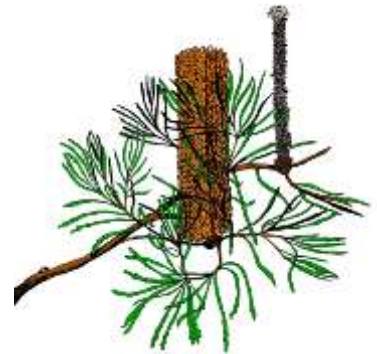

Container: Receptacles in which flowers may be shown. Can be pottery, wood, glass, metal or plastic.  
Vase: Container with height greater than width.  
Arrangement: Flowers arranged according to principles in design with no restrictions as to the use of accessories and/or other materials – e.g. rocks, seeds, drapes etc. Dyed and painted material allowed. BRACTS allowed in all floral art classes.

### **NOVICE SECTION:**

Classes 53, 54, 55, 56 are Restricted to exhibitors who have not had professional/formal training in floristry.

53. Flowers suitable for dining table, height including container not to exceed 25cm
54. Foliage Arrangement
55. Vase of Flowers arranged for effect
