Entries via Showday online is our preferred method of accepting your entries.

Stewards will be in attendance at the Showground Pavilion to accept entry forms and exhibits from 10am – 12 noon SUNDAY 1st July and from 7.30am until 10.30am on FRIDAY 6th July. Exhibits must be collected from the Stewards between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on Sunday 8th July.

Prize money may be collected from the Treasurer's office any time after 9.00am Saturday 7th July.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All exhibits must be the work of the competitor.
2. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class.
3. Exhibits should be in new condition.
4. ALL EXHIBITS must have section, class and name attached by safety pins or sewn –no dressmaking pins please.
5. Work must have not been exhibited at any previous Dayboro Show.
6. Limit of 2 entries per section per exhibitor.

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 for all classes (\$10 for 10 or more items)

PRIZE MONEY: First \$5, Second \$3, Third \$1.

Prize Money may be substituted with a trophy or prize.

W1 Any article with a windmill theme – sewn

W2 Any article with a Windmill theme – knitted or crocheted

W3 Most creative Windmill themed article, to be judged for creativity, minimal needlework is OK – e.g wall hanging with some sewing and glueing etc or windmill on a purchased shirt.
