DIVISION C:

FLORAL ART

Flowers do not need to be grown by the exhibitor for this section.
All are encouraged to enter, with no experience required.
We would love to see lots of entries for a wonderful display this year.

PRIZE MONEY: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7, 3rd - \$3

Container: Receptacles in which flowers may be shown. Can be pottery, wood, glass, metal or plastic.
Vase: Container with height greater than width.
Arrangement: Flowers arranged according to principles in design with no restrictions as to the use of accessories and/or other materials - e.g. rocks, seeds, drapes etc. Dyed and painted material allowed. BRACTS allowed in all floral art classes.

NOVICE SECTION:

Restricted to exhibitors who have not had professional/formal training in floristry.

- 760. Flowers suitable for dining table, height including container not to exceed 25cm
- 761. Foliage Arrangement
- 762. Vase of Flowers arranged for effect
