## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

All Entries must be completed online at <https://showday.online>

PLEASE ENTER and PAY ONLINE PRIOR TO 5<sup>th</sup> July to reduce your waiting time when dropping off entries. Those without internet access will be assisted to enter online at the Showground pavilion.

Stewards will be in attendance at the Showground Pavilion to accept entries and exhibits from 10am - 12 noon SUNDAY 30<sup>th</sup> June and from 7.30am until 10.30am on FRIDAY 5<sup>th</sup> July. Exhibits must be collected from the Stewards between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July.

Prize money may be collected from the Treasurer's office any time after 9.00am Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> July. Prize money not collected by 5.00pm on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 will be forfeited to the Show Society.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All exhibits must be the work of the competitor.
2. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class.
3. Exhibits should be in new condition.
4. ALL EXHIBITS must have section, class and name attached by safety pins or sewn -no dressmaking pins please - This will be emailed to entrant or printed on the day.
5. Work must have not been exhibited at any previous Dayboro Show.
6. Limit of 2 entries per section per exhibitor.
7. The Judge/stewards have the right to place entries into a different class if incorrectly entered.

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 for all classes

PRIZE MONEY: First \$5, Second \$3, Third \$1.

Prize Money may be substituted with a trophy or prize.
