RULES and REGULATIONS:

All Entries must be completed online at <https://v2.showday.online/show/dayboro>

Online entries close WEDNESDAY 1st SEPTEMBER 2021. To reduce your waiting time when dropping off entries. Those without internet access will be assisted to enter online at the Showground Pavilion.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

READ YOUR SCHEDULE CAREFULLY. There are numerous changes to align with COVID-19 requirements and our QLD AgShows Covid Safe Plan.

- Stewards will be at the Showground Pavilion to accept physical exhibits on Sunday 29th August 2021 between 10.00am and 12.00pm and Thursday 2nd September 2021 between 4.00pm and 8.00pm. Sunday entries preferred.
- Prizes and prize money must be collected from Treasurer's Office any time after 10am Saturday 4th September 2021. Prizes and prize money not collected by 5.00pm on Sunday 5th September 2021 will be forfeited to the Show Society.
- Due to Covid requirements, entries MUST be received in a sealed container and entries opened for judging WILL NOT be available for collection post Show as they are required to be destroyed.
- Samples may be entered with your exhibit for judging to enable jars to remain sealed for collection post Show. Please contact dayboroshow.cookery@gmail.com to arrange collection of sample pots PRIOR to 29th August 2021. These containers are to be used to decant a sample of your entries into PRIOR to submission for judging, and will not be accepted if decanted at the Showground Pavilion.
- Unopened jars will ONLY be available for collection on Sunday 5th September between 4:00pm and 5:00pm.
- Points for the Highest Aggregate will be awarded as follows:
1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point.
- Where there are less than THREE (3) exhibits in any class only one (1) prize will be awarded.
- ALL exhibits must be homemade.
- It is the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class. All exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision. No results will be given over the phone.

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 unless otherwise stated.

PRIZE MONEY: First \$5, Second \$3, Third \$1
 Trophies or prizes may be substituted for prize money.

Trophy for Highest Aggregate Points for Classes 800-819.

Scale of Points: 1st - 3 points, 2nd - 2 points, 3rd - 1 point.

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Entry Conditions:

- All exhibits in 375ml or 500ml bottles or jars ONLY.
- All jars MUST be labelled with type of jam/preserve.
- Exhibitor's name must NOT appear on labels.
- Maximum of TWO bottles or jars per exhibitor per class.
- NO repurposed jars from store bought products.
- NO film under lid.
- NO coverings over lid.
