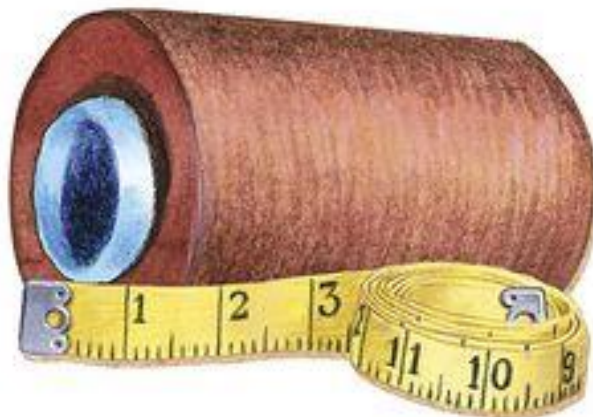

Online Entries close WEDNESDAY 1ST SEPTEMBER 2021

Those without internet access will be asked to complete a paper entry form and will be assisted to place entries online at the showground pavilion.

- Stewards will be in attendance at the Showground Pavilion to accept entries on Sunday 29th August 2021 from 10am to 12pm and Thursday 2nd September 2021 from 4pm to 8pm.
- Please contact the Chief Steward if you are unable to deliver your exhibits in the above times frames.
- Exhibits must be collected from the Stewards on Sunday 5th September 2021. Time slots have been allocated by Surname to comply with COVID-19 Regulations.
 - Needlework: A-F 4.00pm - 4.15pm
G-O 4.15pm - 4.30pm
P-Z 4.30pm - 4.45pm
- Stewards request that if you are collecting exhibits for multiple entrants that you arrive @ 4.45pm.
- Prize money can be collected from the Treasurer's office any time after 10am Saturday 4th September 2021. Prize money not collected by 5pm Sunday 5th September 2021 will be forfeited to the Show Society.
- Pavilions will be closed to general public on Friday 3rd September from 10.30am and again on Sunday 5th September from 3pm to 4pm.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibits must be the work of the competitor.
2. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class.
3. Exhibits should be in new condition.
4. ALL EXHIBITS must have section, class and name attached by safety pins or sewn-no dressmaking pins please - This will be emailed to entrant or printed on the day.
5. Work must have not been exhibited at any previous Dayboro Show.
6. Limit of 2 entries per section per exhibitor.
7. The Judge/Stewards have the right to place entries into a different class if incorrectly entered.
8. Commercially quilted quilts allowed but must be acknowledged.

ENTRY FEE AND PRIZE MONEY:

Entry Fee: \$1.00

Prize Money: First \$5, Second \$3, Third \$1

Trophies or goods may be substituted for prize money.

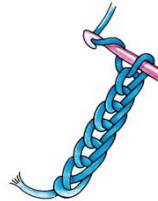
